VIDEO SURVEILLANCE MARKET TO EXPERIENCE EXPLOSIVE GROWTH

ABI Research says revenues in video surveillance to jump from \$13.5B in 2006 to \$46B in 2013.

JACKSONVILLE, FL, May 8, 2008 – A recent study by technology analyst ABI Research forecasts “explosive growth” for the video surveillance market over the next five years amid substantial new market opportunities particularly in the government, transportation, education, retail, and financial market segments. The report cites video analytics, storage and integration improvements, and the rise in IP-based camera technology as catalysts for the fast growth across all industry sectors. The remarkable jump from \$13.5B in 2006 to \$46B by 2013¹ includes cameras, server/storage devices, professional services, software, and hardware infrastructure: all items needed for an end-to-end surveillance system.

“We are already positioned to take advantage of the opportunities the market presents having successfully deployed solutions based on our **Praesidium**[®] intelligent video and alarm monitoring platform,” states Gianni Arcaini, CEO of Duos Technologies. “In the past year alone we have completed major turnkey projects such as our Train Rider Detection System (TRiDS[™]) and Collision Alert Monitoring System (CAMiA[™]) for the transportation sector. The study also notes that overall use of video surveillance systems for both security and marketing operations (such as consumer behavior analysis) is growing globally with little indications of slowing down in the near future. “Another area of substantial growth in the immediate future will be cyber security” adds Arcaini.
